Yuan Ze University Chemical Engineering & Materials Science Department Impoverished Scholarship Launching Measure

Passed at the $\mathbf{6}^{\text{th}}$ Department Faculty Meeting of 2004 dated Mar. 9, 2005

I. Objective:

- (I) The impoverished scholarship is intended to assist avid students from low-income families with poor financial means, allowing them to successfully complete their study.
- (II) The impoverished scholarship is intended to assist those whose families have encountered unforeseeable hindrance to prevent them from continuing to complete their study.
- II. Eligible applicants:

The impoverished scholarship is limited to the undergraduate students at the school's chemical engineering and materials science department, or chemical engineering and materials science graduate students whose family should encounter unforeseeable hindrance to prevent them from continuing to complete their study.

- III. Amount and quota of the scholarship: The quota and amount are to be discussed and determined by the department scholarship committee in accordance with the current year's donated amount.
- IV. Application period:
 - (I) The application is to be filed with one month after each semester starts.
 - (II) Those whose families should encounter unforeseeable hindrance to prevent them from continuing to complete their study may file an application at any given time.

V. Application criteria:

- (I) First-time applicants are required to hold a satisfactory grade point average in academic study, and a disciplinary grade point average of exceeding 80 points. Subsequent applicants are required to hold a satisfactory grade point average in academic study that exceeds the academic grads of the previous filing.
- (II) Those with a grade point average of 75 points or up in academic study are unconfined by the limitations set forth in the preceding section V, (I), provided that their grade point average in disciplinary education for each filing is to reach 80 points or higher.
- VI. Review criteria and procedure:

The review is to be conducted by Yuan Ze University's chemical engineering and materials science department scholarship committee in accordance with the foresaid stipulations, and subject to voluntarily filing with the Department Faculty Meeting before it is made public through open announcement.

VII. Issuing namesake

To encourage donations by generous donors, the scholarship may be issued in the name of the donor, or in a name a donor requests.

VIII. The measure herein will come into effect after approval by the Department Faculty Meeting. Amendments to the Measure shall follow the same procedure ·
